The college ensures representation of both undergraduate and postgraduate students on mandatory committees, thereby promoting inclusivity. A significant recent development is the establishment of an Equal Opportunity Centre, in accordance with UGC guidelines, to enhance support for disadvantaged groups in academic, financial, and social matters, fostering campus diversity. The institution forms internal committees to encourage student participation in various activities, thereby emphasizing team spirit, life skills, and overall personality development.

The active presence of a Student Council and student representation on academic and administrative bodies further amplifies student involvement. Committees such as the Anti-Ragging Committee, Grievance Redressal Committee, Sports Committee, Cultural Committee, Alumni Association Committee, and National Service Scheme incorporate student representatives in the planning and execution of activities, promoting a collaborative approach.

Notably, the Alumni Konnect initiative facilitates online interactions between current students and selected alumni, contributing to a dynamic and engaged student community. The college's commitment to holistic development is evident through these initiatives, providing students with diverse opportunities for growth and engagement.

These efforts highlight the institution's dedication to fostering an inclusive and supportive environment, encouraging active student participation and ensuring a comprehensive developmental experience.
