ACTIVITY REPORT 2021-22

1. **Title of Activity:** Preparation of paper bags using handouts, old news-papers for distribution to medical stores
2. **Date & Venue:** 11/ 04/2022, JSPM's JSCOPR, Hadapsar Pune.
3. **Description of the activity:** A short duration workshop on manual preparation of paper bags/envelops using old newspapers, handouts was conducted by the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of JSPM's Jayawantrao Sawant College of Pharmacy Research, Hadapsar, Pune. The teacher in charge Ms. A. D. Kale explained the purpose of the activity. It is a means of minimizing use of plastic carry bags and an eco-friendly initiative to save trees, reuse the paper and an outreach activity for patients purchasing medicines from the pharmacists. The procedure included a demonstration by the teacher in charge who showed the procedure for folding the paper into a bag/envelop and sealing the edges of the bag with adhesive gel. Subsequently, the students attempted to make the bags as demonstrated. They prepared around 400 paper bags. Students were allotted into groups and were instructed to distribute these bags to retail medical stores in the nearby areas.
4. **Outcome of activity:** It takes centuries for plastic bags to dissolve after ending up in a landfill. Paper bags are eco-friendly and the reuse of paper handouts that are distributed for advertising and promoting the enterprises are seemingly waste. Hence, their reuse is means saving trees as well. Third dimension of this activity is professional, wherein the patients receive the medicines in secondary package. Lastly, it is a small gesture of outreach to the fellow pharmacists and community in general.
